Rules & Regulations for the Tahoe Brewfest of 2017

Food/Beverage Vendors

Parking:

- Parking is not available to vendors of any sort and there will be no driving in or out of the venue on Saturday June 10th, 2017
- Parking is available at the Boys & Girls Club of Lake Tahoe and a shuttle service will be provided to vendors from 9:00am-10:00am to the event and from 5:30-6:30pm from the event back to the Club.
 - If you would like to use the shuttle service provided, please sign-up upon registration with your application. Note: the shuttle service provided only transports people, not equipment.
- Loading/Unloading Zone will be available along Palmira Ave. starting at 7am

Tent/Booth Requirements:

- Each vendor space will be set up with a 6 foot table with ice (cups will be available at purchase of ticket sale). Each beer vendor will also receive 4 brewer credential badges and 4 tasting mugs upon arrival.
- Unloading and loading of product will be done by the businesses and must provide their own means of transportation (i.e. dolly or cart)
- Make sure that all items will fit underneath your tent space of 10' x 10'
- All tent/booth space must be **set up no later than 11am on the day of the event to go through a Fire Marshal check.**
 - All tents must bear CA State Fire Marshal tags and must be shown to be approved by City of South Lake Tahoe
 - Food vendors: no open flame cooking will be permitted within 15' of structures/tents. Fire or heat or any flammable or combustible liquids, gas, charcoal or other cooking devices are not permitted under tents. A Type K fire extinguisher must be next to any open flame or cooking device.
- Power will not be provided or used for any booths
- No alcohol sales are permitted at booths. Tickets must be purchased through the ticket sales and will be monitored closely.
- Decorate your booth and celebrate your businesses uniqueness! We want patrons to know who you are and how you celebrate beer!
- Food vendors must bring any, and all, sanitization required by the Department of Health of El Dorado County.

Please DO NOT:

- Do **NOT** serve anyone with an "under the age" wristband – RED wristbands
 - Feel free to ID anyone that you suspect is under that age of 21. There will be ID checks with they purchase tickets but better safe than sorry!
- Do **NOT** bring any glass items in the beer festival (with the exception of homebrew contest)
- Do **NOT** bring any dogs or other type of animals, as they are not permitted in the area
- Do **NOT** give your vendor badges or vendor mugs to other individuals. This is a fundraiser and we need to remember why we are all here.
- Do **NOT** sell any alcohol at your booth. If someone would like to purchase a ticket, they can go to one of our many ticket booths to purchase. Selling alcohol at your booth violates the alcohol license and will jeopardies the future of this event.

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
